Job Description	<p>This post is for a Consultant based at the Raja Isteri Pengiran Anak Saleha (RIPAS) Hospital, a 600-bedded major tertiary care hospital in Brunei Darussalam. The Paediatric Department is a vibrant unit that provides experience in a diverse range of general paediatric conditions. There is a Neonatal unit with 24 Neonatal Intensive Care cots and 28 Special Care baby Unit cots. There are over 5000 babies born annually at the hospital. The unit provides neonatal intensive care for prematurity, congenital abnormalities and infants requiring surgical interventions.</p> <p>The General Paediatric service, consists of a total of 80 inpatients beds with up to 6000 admissions annually. Additionally, there are 18 High Dependency beds and a 10-bedded Paediatric Intensive care unit. There is a fully dedicated Haemato-oncology floor.</p> <p>The Paediatric outpatient clinic caters for both general paediatrics, development paediatrics and other Paediatric subspecialties with more than 6000 children seen annually.
