

DIRECTIVE 18/2020

UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 4 June 2020,
 - 1.1. Taking into consideration that the situation of COVID-19 in Brunei Darussalam is currently under control, by consent of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, the Ministry of Health wishes to inform the public of additional easing of social distancing restrictions that have been in place since COVID-19 outbreak in the country, as follows:
 - The additional easing of social distancing restrictions will involve tuition schools and music schools, where only private classes or one-on-one classes are temporarily permitted.
 - The additional easing of social distancing restrictions will start on Friday, 13 Syawal 1441H/5 June 2020.
 - The management of the said premises are required to:
 - i) Obtain BruHealth QR code specific for the premises and yang khusus bagi premis-premis tersebut dan seterusnya to print the QR code and

affix it to the entrances to the premises to be scanned by visitors before entering or upon leaving the premises;

- ii) Conduct temperature checking at the entrances and ensure visitors comply to social distancing guidelines; and
- iii) Advise those who are having symptoms of the infection and those who are at high risk of developing severe illness to refrain from coming to the premise.

2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
