

DIRECTIVE 4/2020

UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 10 March 2020, any Brunei residents who have attended a religious gathering (tabligh) at Masjid Jamek Sri Petaling, Kuala Lumpur from 28 February to 3 March 2020 are required to immediately contact 2381383 or 2381380 (office hours only) or Darussalam Hotline 123 (outside working hours) to get advice and examination. Anyone involved in the gathering and currently experiencing symptoms of infection such as fever, cough or difficulty breathing must immediately go to the Flu Centre at Hospital Raja Isteri Pengiran Anak Saleha, located opposite to the entrance to the Emergency Department.
2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
