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FOREWORD

The Ministry of Health has made revision to the Scheme of Charges which was fully implemented on 1st November 1994. The newly revised Scheme of Charges are as specified in Schedule 'A' to 'R' of this booklet. This new Scheme of Charges takes its effect from 1st of July 1998. Therefore all the previous notifications on medical charges are hereby revoked.

The review of the Scheme of Charges is necessary because new services and clinical procedures have been introduced. These revised charges also include services provided by the Laboratory of Scientific Services and other new clinical procedures provided by all Government hospitals.

The Scheme of Charges is aimed at providing a wide range of services accessible to foreign nationals and workers at Government hospitals, health centers and clinics. According to Section 65 Cap 93 of the Labour Act 'The cost of maintenance and treatment of a worker and of his dependents residing in the place of employment in or at any hospital or dispensary to which the worker or his dependent is sent by the employer shall be borne or paid by the employer as long as the workers remain in his employment'. Employers and local contractors are therefore advised to provide medical insurance coverage for their employees.

THE SCHEME OF CHARGES FOR MEDICAL SERVICES

This Scheme of Charges is applicable to all government hospitals, health centres and clinics in Brunei Darussalam.

1. DEFINITIONS

"Children"	includes a legally adopted child.
"Government Servant"	means a person currently employed by the Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di Pertuan.
"Infectious Disease"	means diseases which are classified as infectious disease in accordance with the current international health requirement.
"Investigation"	means the procedure which is considered an aid to diagnosis.
"Treatment"	means medical attention and includes non-invasive procedures and medicines, dressing and other services or surgical intervention.
"Student"	means a person studying full time at school, college or higher educational institution in Brunei Darussalam.
"Ward Charges"	means charges for food (including therapeutic diet) and accommodation only.

2. SCOPE

a) Citizens

Except for the following:-

- i) Registration fee (Schedule A, paragraph 1)
- ii) admission to private wards (Schedule B)
- iii) certain dental procedures (Schedule I)

all medical services will be provided free of charge to a citizen and where applicable to his/her spouse and children.

b) Government Servants

Except for the following:-

- i) Registration fee (Schedule A, paragraph 1)
- ii) admission to private wards (Schedule B)
- iii) certain dental procedures (Schedule I)

all medical services will be provided free of charge to a government servant, his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years ordinarily resident in Brunei Darussalam.

c) Permanent Residents

Except for the following:

- i) Registration fee (Schedule A, paragraph 1)
- ii) admission to private wards (Schedule B)
- iii) permanent implant of pace-maker (Schedule M)
- iv) the radiological examinations and procedures listed in Groups G to I in Schedule E
- v) the operation procedures and Ophthalmic Operation listed in Groups A, B, C, D and E in Schedule F and G respectively.
- vi) certain dental procedures (Schedule I)
- vii) certain medical treatment and investigation

all medical services will be provided free of charge to a permanent resident and where applicable to his children below 18 years of age.

d) Children

Except for registration fee (Schedule A, paragraph 1), which shall be paid in full, all unmarried children between the age of 12 and 18 years whose parents are not citizens will be charged the fees specified in Schedules A to Q but at half rate.

e) Students

Except for registration fee (Schedule A, paragraph 1), which shall be paid in full, a student who does not come within the categories mentioned in paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) will be charged half the rate of fees specified in Schedules A to P provided he/she is able to produce a letter signed by the principal of his/her school, college or higher educational institution.

f) Others

A patient who does not come under any of the above mentioned class of persons will be charged the fees specified in Schedules A to Q.

3. EXEMPTION

- a) State dignitaries specified by His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan's Government are exempted from paying the fees specified in Schedules A to Q.
- b) Royal Brunei Armed Forces, Royal Brunei Police Force and Prison Department personnel and their spouse are exempted from paying the fees specified in Schedule A (1) - Registration Fees.
- c) Cases in Police custody, prisoners and detainees are exempted from paying the fees specified in Schedules A to Q.
- d) Cases of Tuberculosis, Psychiatry, Leprosy and infectious disease which require isolation will not be charged for initial treatment.
- e) No charges will be imposed for immunization, vaccination, investigation or treatment of whatsoever nature during an epidemic or a National Health Campaign.
- f) The Minister of Health may waive part or all medical charges which are beyond a patient's means.

4. HOSPITAL DEPOSIT

- a) Other than in emergency cases, patients are required to pay a deposit of \$200 before being admitted to an ordinary ward or \$400 in the case of a private ward. However, this requirement does not apply to patients who are exempted under this Scheme from paying any charge.
- b) The following may be accepted in place of a cash deposit:
 - i) Letter of Guarantee from banks, insurance companies, or established organisations;
 - ii) Hospitalisation Identity Cards from organisations or companies which have concluded prior agreements with the Ministry of Health.
- c) If the initial deposit becomes depleted before the patient's discharge from hospital, a further deposit will have to be paid.
- d) If at the time of the patient's discharge from hospital, the medical bills incurred by the patient is less than the deposit, the difference will be refunded to the patient.

5. WARD CHARGES

- a) Ward charges are specified in Schedule B.
- b) The day of admission will be counted as one full day.
- c) If a patient is not discharged before 6 pm, the patient will be levied another day's ward charges.
- d) A patient may be admitted to any class of ward of his/her choice subject to availability.
- e) In the case where the selected ward is not available or where the Director of Medical and Health Services directs otherwise than on clinical grounds and a patient is admitted to a ward of a lower or higher class (eg. a private or VIP ward), the patient will be charged only for a lower class ward

6. REFERRALS

- a) Referrals from neighbouring countries to government hospitals will not be accepted unless there is prior agreement between the Ministry of Health Brunei Darussalam and the relevant Ministry of the referring country. However, genuine emergency or accident cases occurring in Negara Brunei Darussalam may be accepted even though there is no such prior agreement, provided the required facilities are available.
- b) No referrals from overseas general practitioners and private dentists will be accepted unless there is a written approval from the Ministry of Health.

7 PRESCRIPTION CHARGES

- a) The charges payable for prescription are as specified in Schedule N
- b) In Patient prescription will include oral therapy, infusion fluids, parenteral medications and intravenous hyperalimentation.
- c) In accordance with standard practice , out patient prescription will not exceed one week's requirement at any one time unless otherwise specified or indicated by the prescribing doctor.
- d) Drugs and medicines once prescribed are not returnable or refundable.
- e) Prescription will be for drugs and medicines listed in the National Standard Drug List .

8. BILLING PROCEDURES

- a) A government servant will be required to furnish a statement signed and stamped by his/her Head of Department stating his/her name and current basic salary. A similar statement will be required for his/her spouse and unmarried children between the ages of 12 and 18 years.
- b) A government servant's hospital charges will be billed and submitted to his/her Department for deduction from his/her salary. However, he/she is encouraged to settle the bill personally.
- c) Hospital bills for patients who are employed by private companies which

have prior arrangements with the Ministry of Health concerning the settlement of hospital bills will be charged directly to their respective companies.

- d) Reminder will be sent to the person concerned after and every two weeks the bills have not been settled. Should outstanding bills remain unpaid after several reminders, the hospital reserves the right to refuse any further treatment or investigation until the outstanding bills are settled.

9. REVISION OF SCHEME

- i) His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di Pertuan's Government may revise all or any part of this Scheme if and when it deems necessary.
- ii) All previous notifications on medical charges are hereby revoked.
