

**CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

The Continuing Professional Development (CPD) requirement consists of an ongoing process of educational and relevant activities that aim to build initial education and training, dedicated to maintain, develop, update or enhance the professional standards, knowledge, skills, values and practice of the Allied Health Professionals.

All registrants must obtain a minimum of 30 CPD points annually as one of the requirements to renew their practising certificate. The list of CPD activities should be recorded in the Continuing Professional Development Log Sheet (AHPCBD/B) which can be downloaded from the Downloadable Documents section.

Should the registrants fail to meet the annual minimum CPD points requirement without valid reason, the AHPCBD may refuse to renew the practising certificate and they would be prohibited from practising in Brunei Darussalam.

For new registrants, the CPD points requirement for the renewal of practising certificate is calculated as follows:

<b>Date of first registration</b>	<b>CPD points required for the renewal of practising certificate next year</b>	<b>CPD points required for the renewal of practising certificate in the subsequent years</b>
January to March	30	30
April to June	20	30
July to September	10	30
October to December	Not required	30
