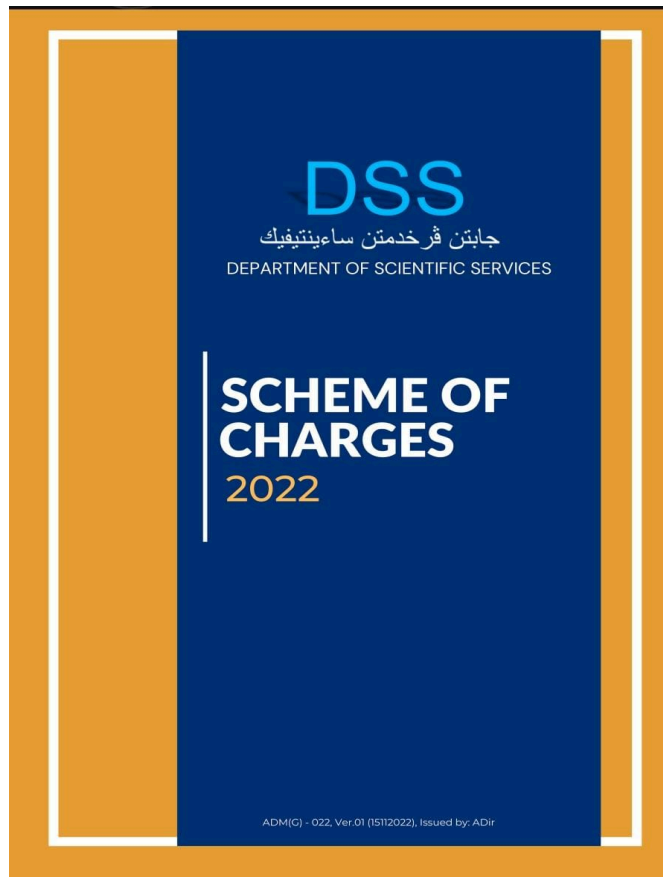

 - b) Cost of vaccines where vaccination is promotional.
 - c) Antenatal and other drugs prescribed at Maternal and Child Health Clinics.
2. Drugs used during hospitalisation other than those mentioned in paragraph 1 above will be charged at cost price to be specified by the Ministry of Health.

3. Under special circumstances, part or all of the prescription charges may be waived by a hospital with the approval of the Minister of Health.

SCHEDULE R

PRIVILEGES FOR BLOOD DONORS

1. REGULAR BLOOD DONORS (DONOR WHO HAS MADE 2 OR MORE DONATIONS WITHIN ANY GIVEN YEAR)

He / she will be entitled to the following for one year; For hospitalisation not exceeding 60 days in a year.

- a) Ward charges payable at HALF the full rate;
- b) Half exemption from payment of charges for medical treatment, surgical operation, and investigations as in Schedule C to P.

2. BLOOD DONOR WHO HAS DONATED BLOOD FOR A MINIMUM OF 30 TIMES

He / She will be entitled to the following:

- a) To all the above benefits under (1) for life;
- b) For all citizens, government servants, and permanent residents, free admission to private wards will be a privilege for life, but subject to availability of beds.

3. CHAMPION DONORS (DONORS WHO HAS MADE 50 OR MORE DONATIONS)

The donor will be entitled to all the above benefits under 2(a) and 2(b) for life. Their spouse and unmarried children under the age of 18 will be entitled the following for life.

- a) Ward charges payable at HALF the full rate;
- b) Half exemption from payment of charges for medical treatment, surgical operation, and investigations as in Schedule C, D, E, F, G, H and N.

c) Free treatment and investigations at out-patient clinics.

Note: For 1, 2, and 3, the above period of hospitalisation must not exceed 60 days per year.
